

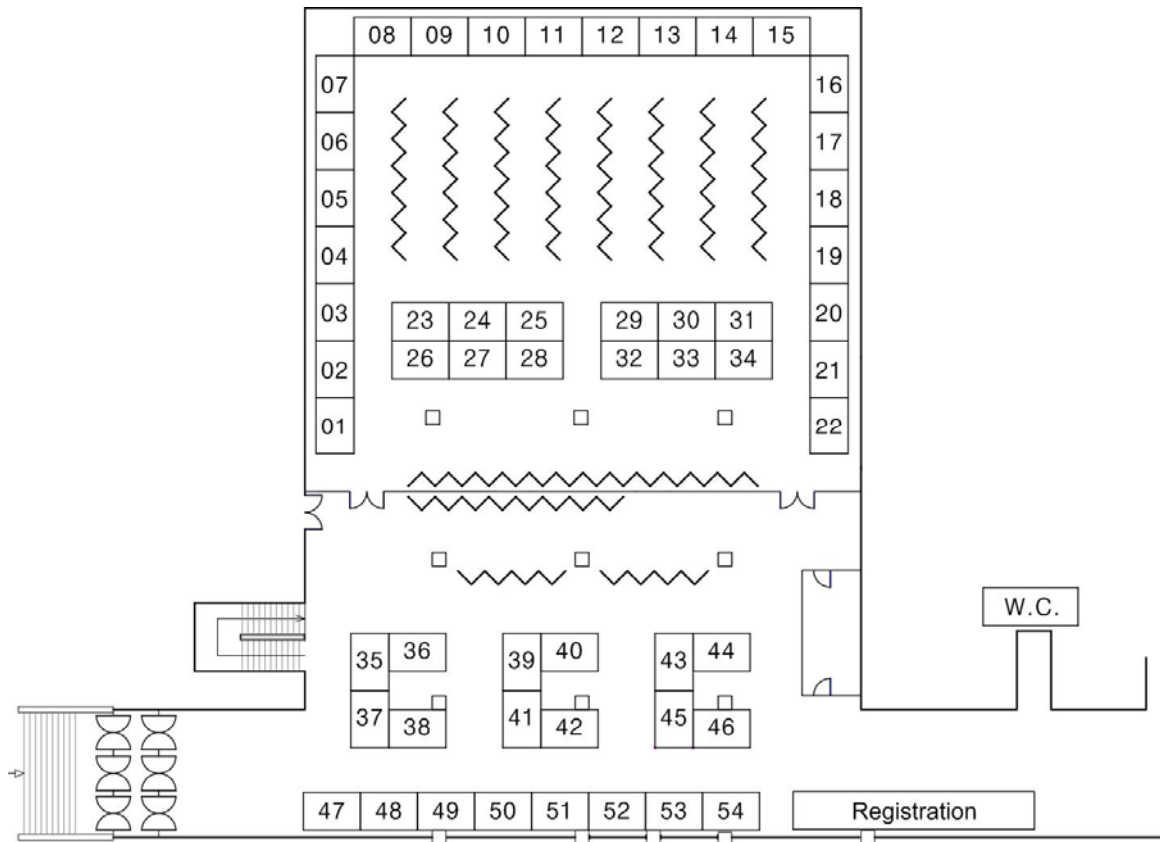

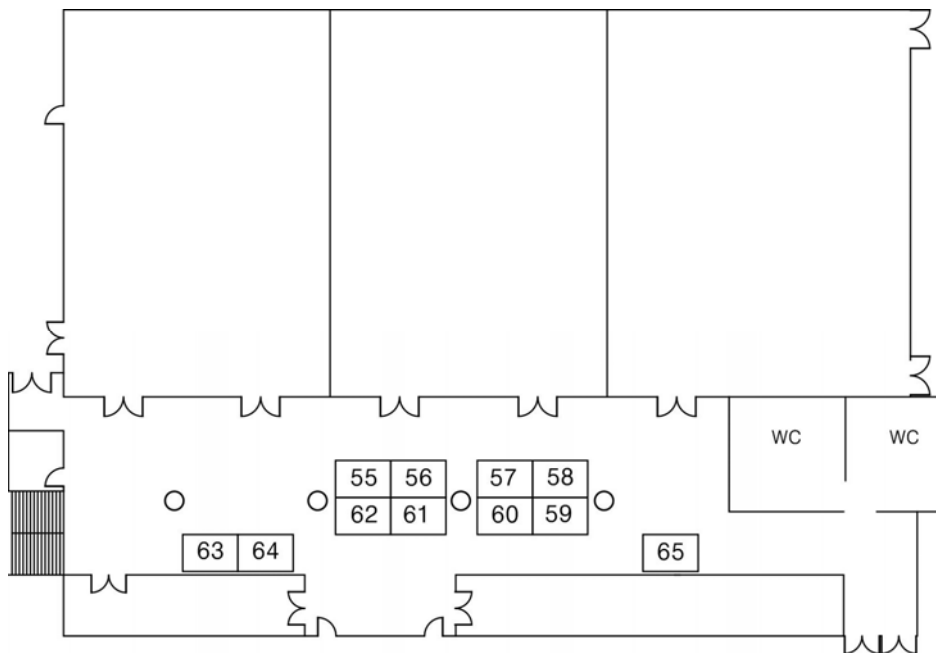

Geomungo Hall Lobby (3rd Floor)





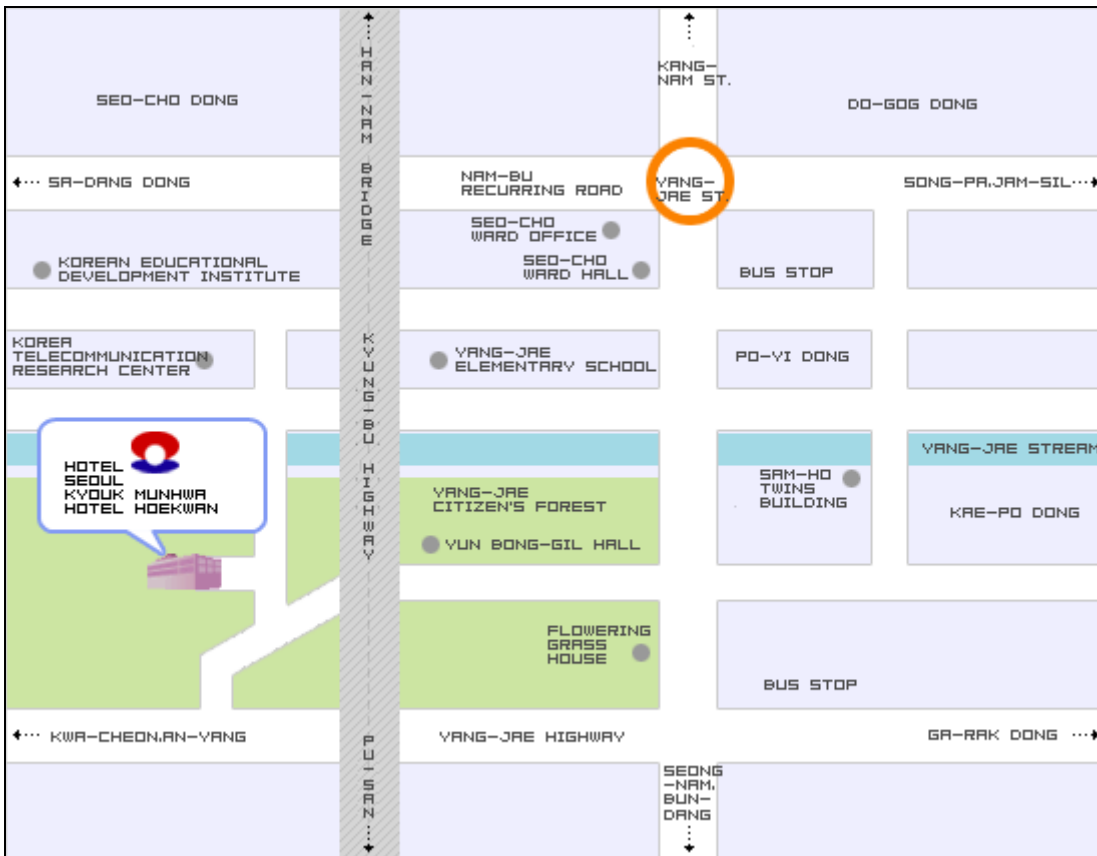
Transportation
